

TOP 10 things to keep **OUT** of your bin.



When haulers see anything in plastic bags, they have been trained to treat them as trash. We need loose recyclables at our Materials Recycling Facility.



Plastic bags can only be recycled in our ReSTORE boxes at most grocery stores. Do not place them in your blue bin, or put paper in them before placing in your green bin.



Napkins, paper towels & toilet paper are already too low a grade of paper to be recycled, & can pose health hazards.



Needles should be placed in a hard container like a bleach bottle or coffee can, capped, taped shut, label "SHARPS" and placed in your regular trash.



Containers that held hazardous waste such as automotive fluid or pesticides must be treated specially. If completely empty, place in trash. If not, call 942-1430 ext. 241 more information.



Greasy pizza boxes & other paper materials with food residues are not accepted for recycling.



Bottles and jugs should be emptied of liquids before placing in your blue bin. You can put the cap back on before recycling.



Paper packaging designed for your freezer or fridge is treated in a way that prevents breakdown in the recycling process. These belong in the trash.



Paper and foam alike, disposable coffee cups are not accepted for recycling. Prevent waste all together & bring your own mug.



Plastic jugs & bottles numbered with #1 and #2 are the **ONLY** plastics that go in your blue bin. Other shapes of #1 and #2 plastic & all #s 3-7 go in the trash.
