At a meeting of the Town Council of West Greenwich, RI holden on August 25th, 1923 the following Ordinance was passed and accepted.

Voted - That the following ordinance be and the same hereby is accepted and made an ordinance for the licensing and maintenance of taverns, victualling houses, etc., in the Town of West Greenwich, RI.

An ordinance to regulate the licensing and maintenance of taverns, victualling houses, road side stands, etc.

It is ordained by the Town Council of the Town of West Greenwich, Rhode Island as follows:

- Section 1. No person shall keep open or maintain or conduct any tavern, victualling house, cook shop, oyster house, oyster cellar or any other place of business, dispensing or serving lunches or refreshemts of any kind without first having obtained from the Town Council of said West Greenwich, a license disignating the place where such tavern, shop or place of business is located, and the owners or keepers name thereof.
- Section 2. Any person procurring such license as aforesaid shall pay to said Town of West Greenwich, a license fee, the sum thereof to be subject to requirments of the Town Council of said Town of West Greenwich.
- Section 3. Nothing in this ordinance or any part thereof shall be construed to refer to any grocery store, and it shall be the privilege of said Town Council to determine what constitutes a grocery store.
- Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect upon and after its passage.
