

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING IMPROPER  
CONDUCT, REVELING AND DRUNKENNESS

It is ordained by the Town Council of the Town of West Greenwich as follows:

1. Every person who disturbs the peace of the town by fighting, reveling or otherwise behaving in a disorderly manner in any public place in the town or in any establishment or club which sells or serves alcoholic beverages or in any other place which caters to the public shall be fined not exceeding one hundred (100) dollars, or imprisoned not exceeding thirty (30) days.

2. Every person who shall be found intoxicated under such circumstances as to amount to the violation of decency in any highway, street, gangway or other public place in the town shall be fined not exceeding one hundred (100) dollars, or imprisoned not exceeding thirty (30) days.

3. Every person who shall commit any nuisance or shall be found quarreling, fighting, reveling or otherwise behaving in a disorderly or indecent manner to the disturbance of the orderly people of the town or who shall aid, incite or encourage the same to be done shall be fined not exceeding one hundred (100) dollars, or imprisoned not exceeding thirty (30) days.

4. Every person who shall prowl or wander upon the private property of another, peek in the door or window of any inhabited building or structure located thereon without visible or lawful business with the owner or occupant thereof shall be fined not exceeding one hundred (100) dollars, or imprisoned not exceeding thirty (30) days.

5. Every person who shall display any deadly weapon in a public place in a manner which is calculated to alarm or frighten other persons present shall be fined not exceeding one hundred (100) dollars, or imprisoned not exceeding thirty (30) days.

6. This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
